[2017 MILITARY COMMITTEES' BRADLEY ESPOSITO CONTINUING EDUCATION PROGRAM]

Objective

The 2017 Indianapolis ASMC Military Committees' Bradley Esposito Continuing Education Scholarship Program is designed to provide financial assistance to Service members for their continuing educational endeavors. The program encourages the development of local chapter Service Members' continuing education programs.

Award Criteria

Applicant must be a member or corporate member designee in good standing of ASMC and currently Enlisted and serving in the Military (Active or Reserve status). Applicant needs to be currently serving in the Military prior to the submission due date.

- Applicant must be entering or be in a business or resource management field of study relating to military comptrollership. (Business Administration, Economics, Public Administration, Accounting, Finance, etc.)
- In order to be eligible for the Military Scholarship, Applicant must be in good standing at their unit.
- Applicant's justification of desired educational outcome will be the key factor in selection.
- Applicant must have three letters of recommendation from (1) Service Members Commander (03 or above), (2) First Line Leader and (3) academic institution official on official letterhead or in official email.
- Applicant must submit an essay of 500 words or less expressing why they are deserving of a the 2017 ASMC Military Committees' Bradley Esposito Continuing Education Scholarship
- No applicant will be permitted to be an ASMC Military Committees' Bradley Esposito Continuing Education Scholarship Program award recipient consecutively.

Award Selection Procedures

A selection panel, chaired by the local Scholarship Committee, will review all applications received and make final recommendations to the ASMC Indianapolis Chapter, who will approve final

award winners. Chapter Presidents will be notified by e-mail in November the applicant that has been selected as a winner. Selection will be based on individual merit and other criteria outlined above.

Recognition

Indianapolis ASMC Military Committee will provide one Bradley Esposito Continuing Education Scholarship annually; at \$1,000 each. Notification of course enrollment and a completed W-9 will be required before disbursement of the grant check(s) to the chapter. Grants will be presented to the Enlisted member by the appropriate local ASMC Chapter. The recipients may be publicized at meetings, in newsletters, and in the *Armed Forces Comptroller*.
